July 13-17, 2020

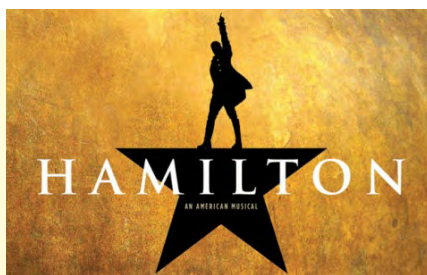

July 20 - 31, 2020

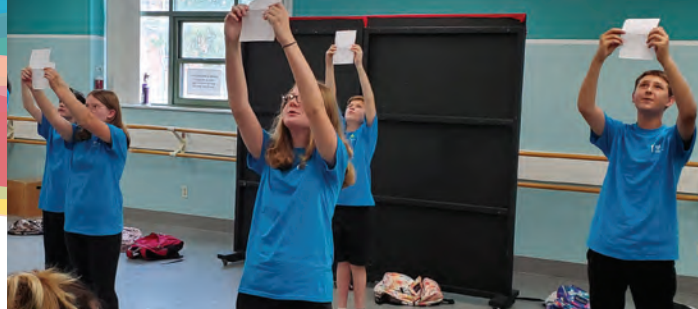

Private Voice Instruction

Ages 9 - 18

TUITION: Tuition for ADVENTURE camp is \$280/per week (full-day) or \$140/ per week (half-day). A discount will be applied to each additional week of ADVENTURE camp a child enrolls in for **a maximum discount of \$50 per week (full-day) or \$25 per week (half-day).**

Deposits: A non-refundable deposit of \$25 per week must be submitted with registration form to reserve your spot on the camp roster. You will be invoiced for the remaining camp balance.

Registration Fee: There is a one-time, non-refundable registration fee of \$50 for all **first time PYT students or campers.**

Terms of Agreement:

- Each student wishing to enroll in a PYT summer camp must submit a completed enrollment form and \$25 non-refundable per week deposit. No discounts offered for Showtime Camps, Private Voice Instruction or Before and/or After care. Full payment is due 3 weeks prior to first day of camp.
- **TUITION IS NON-REFUNDABLE** except for withdrawals **made in writing** a minimum of 14 days prior to start of camp.
- The camper and parents agree to abide by the rules set by PYT staff for the health, safety, and welfare of all the campers and staff.
- Photography Policy: Pennsylvania Youth Theatre reserves the right to use photographs and video taken during classes and other programs for the promotion of the organization. Any student, parent or guardian who DOES NOT wish to be/have child photographed **must notify PYT upon registration.**
- PYT Staff reserves the right to deny, cancel, sever, or suspend a child's enrollment if deemed in the best interest of the camper or the camp. There will be no refunds.
- I authorize the officials of the camp to act on my behalf while my child is in their care, including the power to authorize emergency medical treatment.
