Ahoy, mateys! Set sail on a swashbuckling adventure in this pirate-themed camp.

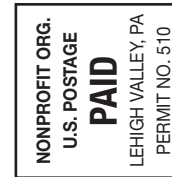
Adventure Camp Week 6, Alice in Wonderland • July 21 - 25

Experience the enchantment of Disney in this magical camp week, where campers will step into the shoes of their favorite Disney characters!

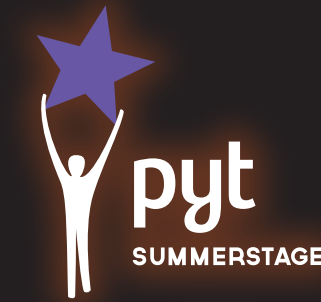
Adventure Camp Week 8, Dino Discovery • August 4 - 8

Private Voice Lessons

PRIVATE VOICE INSTRUCTION

Ages 9 - 18

PYT is happy to offer affordable Private Voice Lessons to our students, ages 9-18. Students will work on how the singing voice is produced, learn breathing techniques, and also how to create tone through a series of practical exercises. Source material includes the classical repertoire, as well as Broadway scores.

By appointment only with one of PYT's highly qualified Vocal Instructors. Tuition includes SIX lessons that are each 30 or 60 minutes in length.

SIX 1 Hour Lessons: \$425

Lessons will be scheduled on a first-come, first-served basis. Instructors' schedules are varying, so we will try to accommodate you the best we can based on availability.

TUITION: Tuition for ADVENTURE camp is \$320/per week (full-day) or \$160/per week (half-day). A discount will be applied to each additional week of ADVENTURE camp a child enrolls in for a **maximum discount of \$50 per week (full-day) or \$25 per week (half-day).**

Deposits: A non-refundable deposit of \$25 per week must be submitted with registration form to reserve your spot on the camp roster. You will be invoiced for the remaining camp balance.

Registration Fee: There is a one-time, non-refundable registration fee of \$50 for all **first time PYT students or campers.**

Terms of Agreement:

- Each student wishing to enroll in a PYT summer camp must submit a completed enrollment form and \$25 non-refundable per week deposit. No discounts offered for Showtime Camps, Private Voice Instruction or Before and/or After care. Full payment is due 3 weeks prior to first day of camp.
- TUITION IS NON-REFUNDABLE** except for withdrawals made in writing a minimum of 3 weeks prior to start of camp.
- IMPORTANT:** The safety of our students, faculty, and staff remains of the utmost importance. We will continue to follow all safety guidelines from the CDC and local government agencies. The camper and parents agree to abide by the rules set by PYT staff for the health, safety, and welfare of all the campers and staff.
